This agreement has enabled the completion of doctoral theses on subjects related to products from Ercros's pharmaceutical division, the use of limited-access equipment, and highly specialized technical assistance in chemical-pharmaceutical processes.

The award was accepted by the division's Head of Human Resources, Juan Ignacio Ledesma, at an event where various specialists discussed—in a panel discussion format— topics such as the implications of AI for medical research, legal analysis, and patent drafting.
